

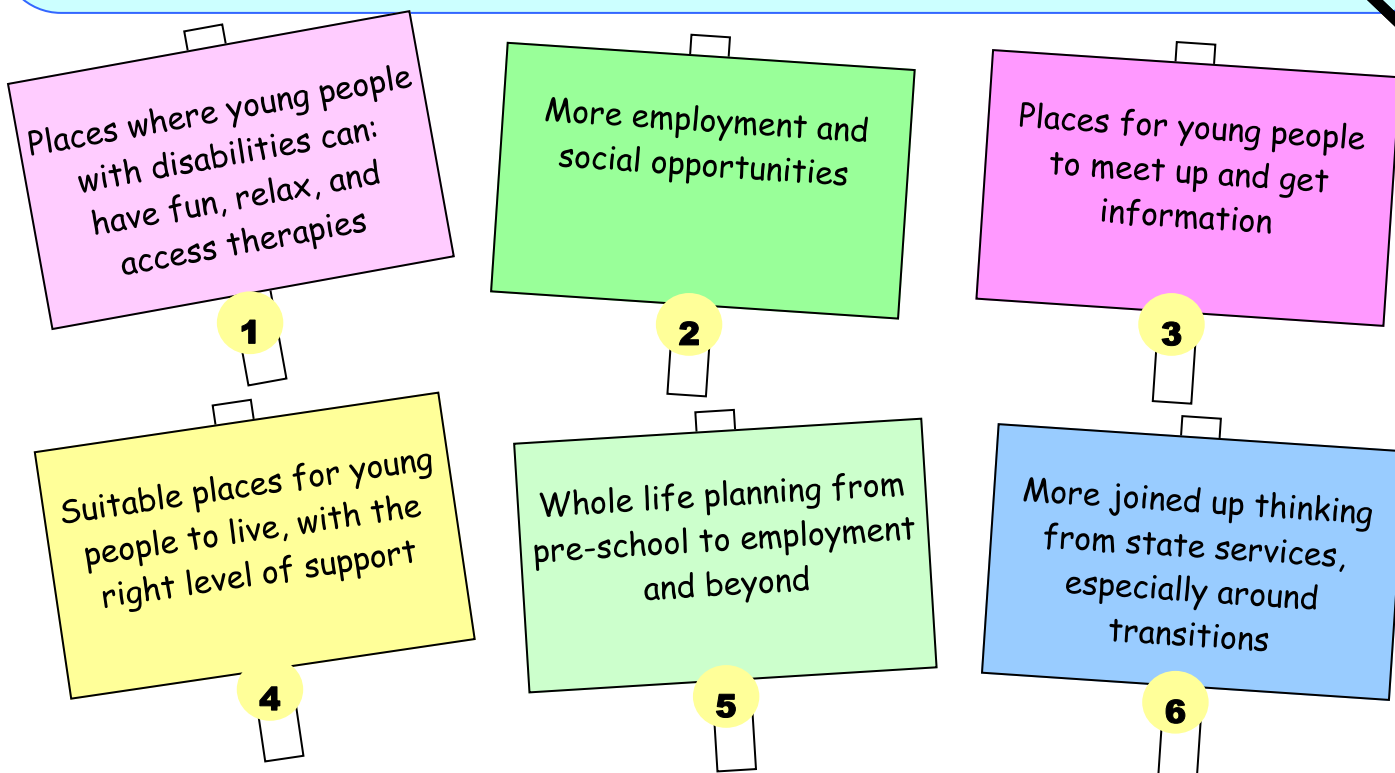


### Update from the Parents Meetings on 22nd and 26th April

9 parents, 1 young person and 2 project staff attended the 2 meetings, at the Angel Hotel Abergavenny and the Therapy Den in Usk. We focussed on a 'Magic Wand Question': If you had a magic wand, what would you create that would give your son or daughter, and other young people with additional needs, a good adult life?

The responses we had are written on the placards below. They fall into 4 themes:

**Somewhere to live; Employment; Places to go; Better planning.**
